

The Loosening of the Labor Market?

- Job growth relatively flat through 2024 (until December)
- Quits rate finally dropping
- Wage growth slowed to 3.9%
- US unemployment rate finally inched back over 4% for the first time since 2021 (currently at 4.1%)
- Return to work
- Gen Al
- Employer friendly legislative landscape



The Voluntary Quits Rate







JOBS GROWTH

Texas added 274,300 jobs from November 2023 to November 2024. Texas' annual nonfarm growth rate reached **2.0 percent**, outpacing the U.S. growth rate by 0.6 percentage points.

UNEMPLOYMENT RATE

The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate rose a tenth of a point to 4.2 percent over the month in Texas. The U.S. unemployment rate was also 4.2% in November.

LABOR FORCE PARTICIPATION RATE

After another month of job growth, the Texas labor force participation rate has reached a 10-year high, at 64.7 percent (compared to the U.S. at 62.5%). The total civilian labor force in Texas reached over **15.5 Million** in November for the first time in history.

HBR: How Gen Al is Already Impacting the Labor Market

Harvard Business Review analyzed 1,388,711 job posts from a leading global online freelancing platform from July 2021 to July 2023

- The introduction of ChatGPT and image-generating tools led to nearly immediate decreases in posts for online gig workers across ALL job types
- After the introduction of ChatGPT, there was a 21% decrease in the weekly number of posts in automation-prone jobs compared to manual-intensive jobs:
 - Writing jobs, (30.37% decrease)
 - Software, app, and web development (20.62% decrease)
 - Graphic Design & 3D Modeling freelancers (17% decrease)*
 *after the intro of image-generating AI tools
 - Engineering (10.42% decrease)

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
Comparing gen Al's hits to robotic automation, researchers looked at a study done in France from 2010-2015:

A 20-percentage-point increase in robot adoption in French manufacturing led to only a 3.2% decline in industry employment

Indeed: The share of job postings referencing Gen AI more than tripled between September 2023 and September 2024
